What might a Backing the Future grant look like?

Grow the Future - Bega, NSW

Focus Area: Caring for the Environment In 2022, Bega local Callum Champagne had a vision for a regenerative farm that produces local food for the community, while also providing training and employment for young people.

With his \$50,000 Backing the Future grant, Callum purchased equipment, materials and consultancy support to kickstart the concept.



This idea has now grown into a social enterprise that grows food and cares for land in Bega Valley. The two-acre farm includes a market garden, small animal systems, a training and social space, an outdoor kitchen, kitchen garden and native regeneration zones.

The farm will continue to offer young people opportunities to engage in a supportive and inspiring 'hands-on' program, vocational training and paid employment.
